Thematic Calls:

In recent years, the amount of data produced across all disciplines has increased exponentially. While providing troves of valuable information, the risk of exposure to potential attacks and data loss has followed this growth. As a result, there is increasing demand to develop security analysis techniques to predict and mitigate various attacks. The goal of this interdisciplinary session is to provide a platform for data mining practitioners and cybersecurity experts to collaborate and discuss the overlap of applications, issues, and challenges.

Topics of interest include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Internet of Things (IoT) security
- Biometric authentication
- Intrusion Detection
- Penetration Testing
- Wireless networking
- Cloud computing
- Threat modeling

Challenges to be addressed include but are not limited to:

- Analyzing large quantities of packet captures
- Managing large-scale IoT networks
- Securing biometric data
- Blockchain transaction analysis
- Enterprise security applications
