As a result, there is increasing demand to develop security analysis techniques to predict and mitigate various attacks. The goal of this interdisciplinary session is to provide a platform for data science practitioners and cybersecurity experts to collaborate and discuss the overlap of applications, issues, and challenges. Applications of data science to cybersecurity are of primary interest.
